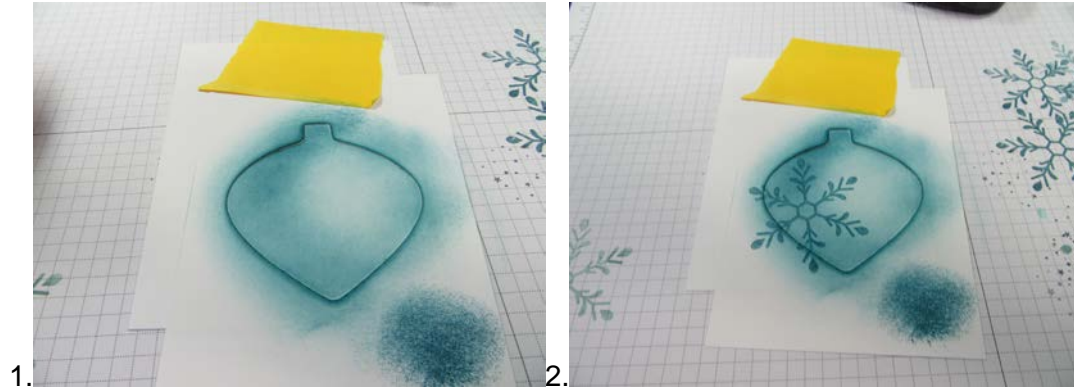
CARD STOCK:

Thick Whisper White #140272	4-1/4 x 11, score and fold at 5-1/2 – card base
	4 x 5-1/4 – card front
	1 x 2 – scrap for sentiment
Regular Whisper White #100730	4 x 5-1/4 – to create the stencil
Crumb Cake #120953	4 x 5-1/4
Whisper White #100730	2-1/2 x 4
Silver Glimmer Paper #135314	1-1/2 x 4

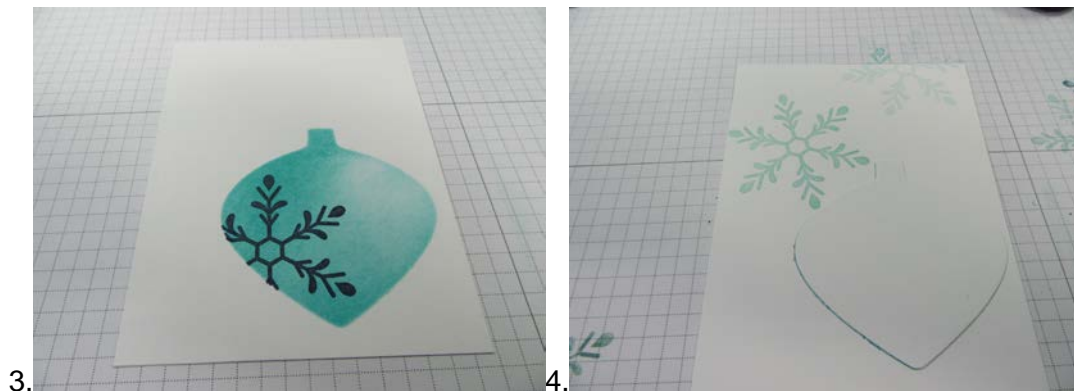


INSTRUCTIONS:

As you stamp the images over the stencil/mask, there will be a little halo or void in the ink where it steps down from the two layers of card stock. Use the inkpad lids and the blender pen to fill this in. (shown in video)



1. Die cut the ornament from the piece of regular Whisper White and save both pieces. Secure the outline piece (stencil) over the bottom right corner of the card front and use the two inks to sponge the ornament.
TIP – I covered the entire piece in Pool Party then went back and highlighted the left side with the Island Indigo.
TIP – I'm using Post It Note Tape to hold my stencil in place.
2. Stamp the snowflake in Island Indigo – the stencil/mask should still be in place to protect the rest of the piece.



3. Remove the stencil/mask to reveal your beautiful ornament.
4. Cover the ornament with the cut out piece.
 - Use the Stampin Mist and Scrub to clean the stamp.
 - Ink the snowflake stamp in Pool Party, stamp once to the left of the ornament and again above it and to the right without reinking. You can stamp over the ornament as it is protected; and doing this adds a little depth to the art piece.

5. Remove the mask and using the Island Indigo Ink, stamp the small stamp that has dots and stars on it, randomly on the piece for some background noise.
 - Attach the card front to the card base using Snail Adhesive.
6. Loop the Silver Metallic Thread 3 times and use a small piece of Scotch Tape to secure it. Attach it just above the ornament with a Glue Dot.

7. Stamp the word "Christmas" on the scrap of Whisper White, trim, sponge the edges with Island Indigo and attach above the ornament with Dimensionals (cut in half to fit).

TIP – this sentiment will also cover the scotch tape in the thread.
8. Use the Christmas Greetings Thinlits to cut the word "merry" from the piece of Silver Glimmer Paper. Use multi-purpose glue to attach it to the card just above the word "Christmas".

9. Embellish with the Bermuda Bay Sequins and the medium sized Rhinestones.
10. Clean the stamps with the Stampin Scrub and Mist.
