

# Wonderland - Stampin' Up!

Technique: Northern Lights

Level: Beginner - Intermediate



**TIME: 20 minutes or less**

**STAMPS:**

Wonderland  
#139752 (wood)  
#140365 (clear)  
White Christmas  
#135767 (photopolymer)

**INKS:**

VersaMark #102283 (for heat embossing)  
Elegant Eggplant #126969  
Island Indigo #126986  
Cucumber Crush #138324  
Bermuda Bay #131171  
Night of Navy #126970  
StazOn Black #101406 or Memento Black #132708.

**ACCESSORIES:**

Big Shot #129053, Sleigh Ride Edgelits #139670  
Heat Tool #129053, Embossing Buddy #103083, White Embossing Powder #109132  
Snail Adhesive #104332 or Fast Fuse #129026.  
Stampin Sponges #101610 – cut into 6ths, one for each ink color (excluding black)  
Stampin Scrub #126200 and Stampin Mist #102394

**CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:**

Bermuda Bay #131197	5-1/2 x 8-1/2, score and fold at 4-1/4 – card base
Basic Black #121045	3-7/8 x 5-1/8 – mat for art piece
Whisper White #100730	3-3/4 x 5 – art piece
	4-1/4 x 5-1/2 – die cut sleigh and horse
	4 x 5-1/4 – inside of card

**DIRECTIONS:**

- 1 Use the sponges to add the ink to the art piece as per video instructions.
- 2 Stamp the trees in StazOn Black or Memento.
- 3 When the ink is dry, rub the entire piece with the Embossing Buddy to make sure there are no sticky spots.
- 4 Stamp the snowflake stamp in VersaMark Ink, cover with white embossing powder, shake off excess and heat set.
- 5 Use the Big Shot to die cut the sleigh Edgelit from white card stock.
- 6 Use Snail Adhesive or Fast Fuse to attach the die cut to the front of the art piece.
- 7 Attach the art piece to the black mat and then to the card base.
- 8 Clean the stamps with the Stampin Scrub and Mist.
