

# Stampin' Up! – Totally Trees

Technique: Side Spring Card

Level: Beginner - Intermediate

**CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:**

Pool Party Card Stock #122924

5-1/2 x 8-1/2 – card base

With the Short side across the top, score at 2-3/4.

With the Long Side across the top, score at 2-3/4 and 4.

Rich Razzleberry #115316

4 x 4 – die cut scalloped square

Whisper White #100730

3-1/2 x 3-1/2 – die cut square

2-1/2 x 4-1/4 – inside of card

Petals & Paisleys Specialty Designer Paper  
#142017 – Rich Razzleberry floral.

3/4 x 4-1/4 – bottom front of card

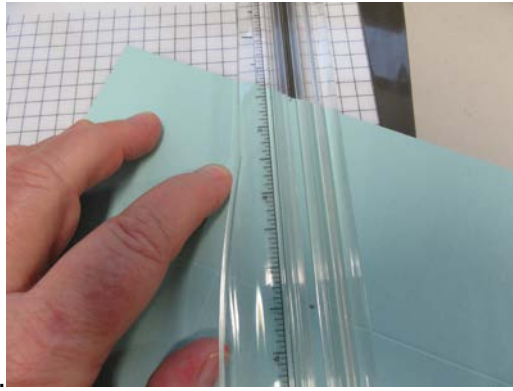
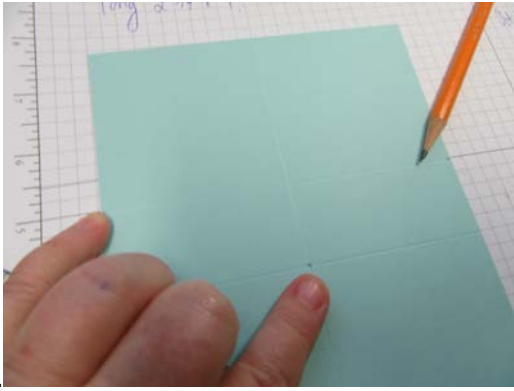
1/4 x 4-1/4 – bottom inside of card.

**DIRECTIONS:**

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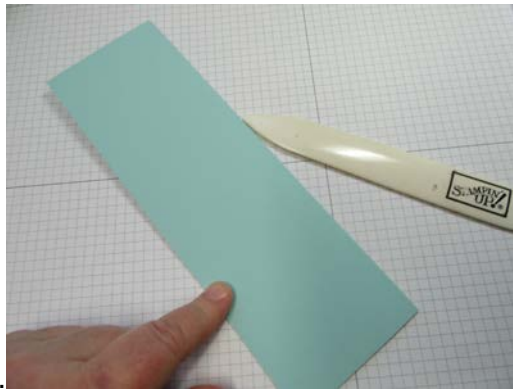
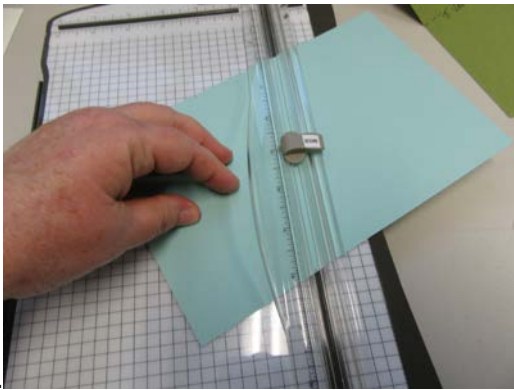
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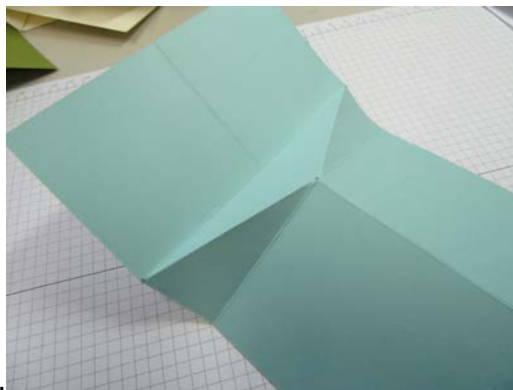
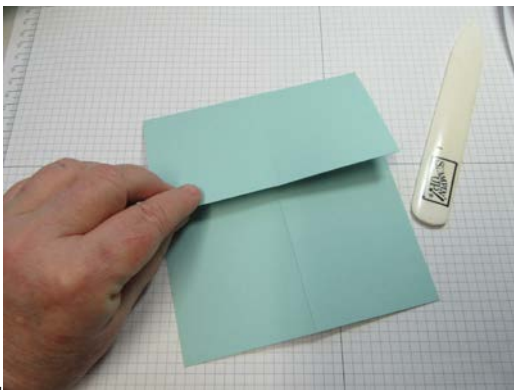


1. – With the Short side across the top, score at 2-3/4.  
 - With the Long Side across the top, score at 2-3/4 and 4.  
 - Mark both ends of the 2-3/4" score line with a pencil  
 - Mark the center of the 4" score line

2 – Line the pencil marks up in the cutting groove of the Stampin Trimmer and use the scoring tab to score from the outside edge of 2-3/4" to the center of the 4" score.

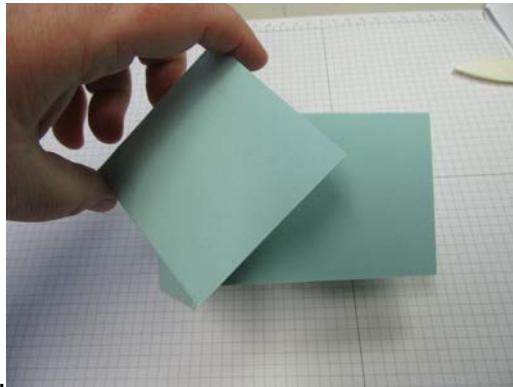
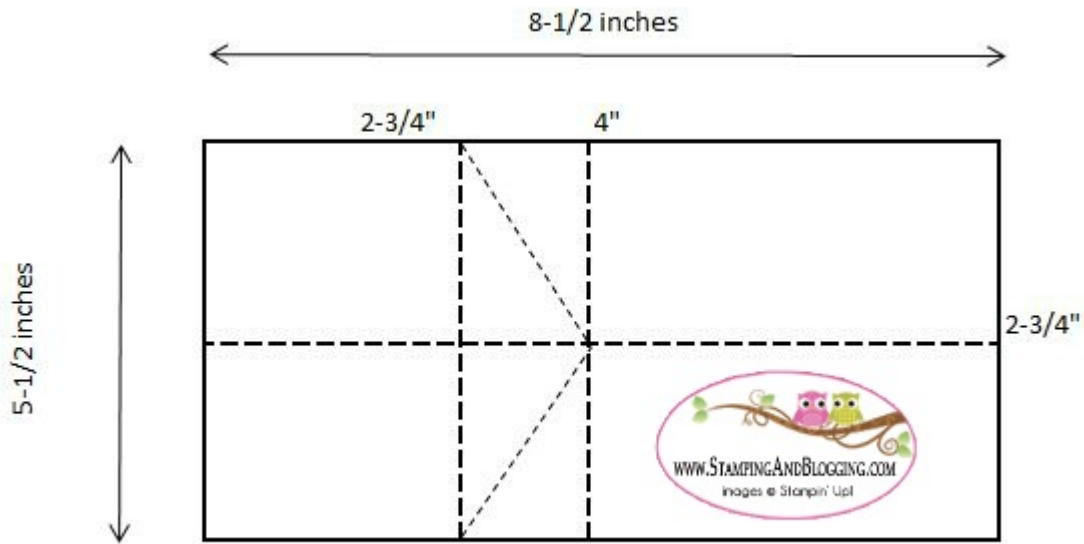


- 3 – Turn the card stock and repeat on the other side.  
 4 – Use a bone folder to burnish all the score lines and fold them both ways to break down the fibers.  
 TIP – folding both ways will really help the spring portion of the fold lay flat.



- 5 – The outside two score lines are valley folds.  
 6 – The inside angled score lines are mountain folds.



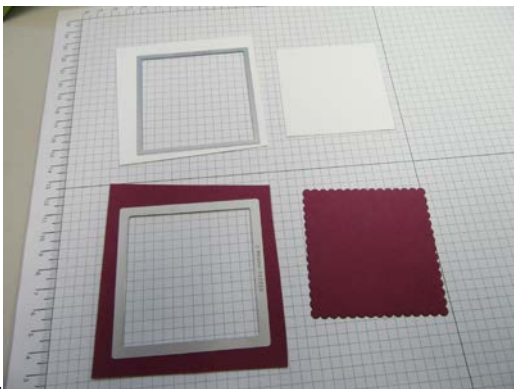


7. 8.

7 – At this point you can erase your pencil marks.

8 – As you fold the card closed, the square on the left side will “spring” into place.

**TIP** – I detailed this heavily in the video.



9. 10.

9 – Use the Big Shot and the Layering Square Framelits to cut the two art pieces out. Rich Razzleberry is cut with the largest scalloped square framelit.

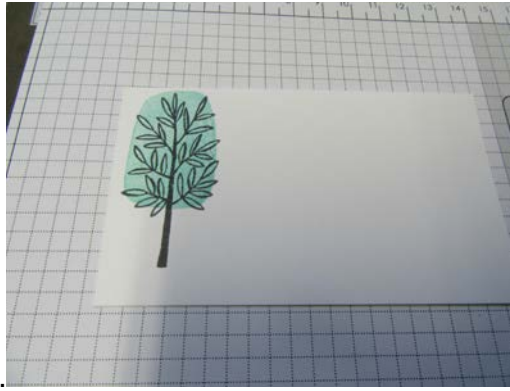
Whisper White is cut with the second largest plain square framelit.

10 – Use the Basic gray Archival Ink to stamp the trees.

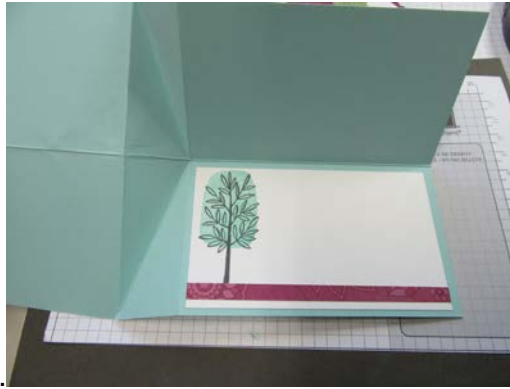

11 – This is a two-step stamp set, so use the solid images and overstamp the trees, one in Rich Razzleberry the other in Pear Pizzazz.

12 – Repeat with the inside card piece, stamping the second solid image in Pool Party ink.

20 – Use Multipurpose Glue to attach the skinny piece of designer paper along the bottom of the inside card piece.

21 – Then adhere it to the inside of the card.

22 – Adhere the wider piece of Designer Paper to the outside front of the card.

23 – Adhere the art piece to the mat.





24. 25.

24 – I chose these three words for my card.

25 – Stamp the word “congrats” on the front art piece and then use Fast Fuse to attach it to the front Spring Square.

**TIP** – for the Tutorial I stamped in Old Olive, for the Video, I stamped it in Rich Razzleberry, which I liked better.



26. 27.

26 – Use the Basic Gray Archival Ink to stamp the second sentiment on the card front.

27 – And, the third sentiment inside the card.



28. 29.

28 – When your card is completed, and you open it up, the one side looks like this.

29 – The other side looks like this.

30 – Clean stamps with the Stampin Scrub and Mist.
