

Stampin' Up! – Southern Serenade

Technique: Aqua Painter & Die cutting

Level: Beginner - Intermediate

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

Thick Whisper White #140272	5-1/2 x 8-1/2, score and fold at 4-1/4 – card base
Lemon Lime Twist #144245	4 x 5-1/4 – mat
Whisper White #100730	3-7/8 x 5-1/8 – card front
Watercolor Paper #122959	2 x 4 – flowers
Marina Mist #119682	3 x 3 – frame
Lemon Lime Twist	1x 2 – die cut the word “you”
Basic Black #121045	1-1/2 x 4 – die cut the word “celebrate”.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Stamp the floral image onto the watercolor paper with the Archival Basic Black Ink. When dry, paint with the aqua painter and the inkpad lids and cut out



2. Place the 2nd from largest Stitched Shape Square Framelit on the piece of Marina Mist. Add the smaller Layering Squares framelit that fits inside. Center the inside die and use post it notes to hold it in place while you run it through the Big Shot.
3. Use the Celebrate You Thinlits to cut out the two sentiments.
4. Place the Whisper White card front inside the embossing folder and run it through the Big Shot.
5. Attach the card front to the mat and then to the card base.
6. Use Multipurpose glue to attach the bottom of the flower stem inside the frame and then attach both pieces to the card front.
7. Raise the top of the flower image with a couple of Mini Dimensionals for added interest.
8. Use Multipurpose glue to attach the word “celebrate”
9. Cut a couple of Mini Dimensionals in half to attach the word “you”.
10. Clean stamps with the Stampin Scrub and Mist.
