COPIC MARKERS:

Hat: BG 49, BG 13, BG 15, Fingers and Nose: E 01, E 13, Leaves: YG 23, G 28, Y 06 Feet: NO 7, NO 3, No 2 Caterpillar: R 17, Y 38, Y 19 Branch and swing seat: E 00, E 33,

E 35, E37

ACCESSORIES:

Sizzix Big Shot Sixxix Magnetic Platform

Misti Precision Stamping Tool Gina K Connect Glue

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

Neenah Class Crest White 80 LB.

4-1/4 x 11, score and fold at 5-1/2 – card base

 $3-1/2 \times 4-3/4$ – to die cut the art piece Scraps – to stamp and cut out leaves

4 x 5-1/4 – to die cut the mat

Stampin Up Bermuda Bay

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Score the card base at 5-1/2 and fold.
- 2. Use the Big Shot and the Wonky Rectangle Dies to cut out the art piece and mat.
- 3. Use the Misti Precision Stamping Tool to stamp the image on the art piece.
- 4. Color with Copics. Also, colour some additional branch and leaf pieces to cut out.
- 5. Adhere the Bermuda Bay Mat to the card base using the Gina K Connect Glue
- 6. Adhere the art piece to the center of the card front using the Foam Mounting Squares



- 7. Cut out and adhere the extra leaves and branches using the Gina K Connect Glue.
- 8. Embellish with the Caribbean Sunset Sequins.
- 9. Clean stamps with the Stampin Scrub and Mist.
