
Celebrating You Today - Simon Says Stamp

Ranger Non-stick craft sheet Tombow Multi-purpose Glue Tim Holtz Guillotine Paper Cutter Score Pal Mini Tim Holtz scissors Copper thread TIME: about 15 minutes or less

Daisy Bouquet - Simon Says Stamp

INK:

Simon Says Stamp – Khaki Die Ink Gansai Tambi watercolors: 31, 33, 44, 43

Winsor & Newton Gouache (white paint for splattering).

Die cutting machine

Eucalyptus Leaves dies, Simon Says Stamp

Tumbling Leaves Stencil – Simon Says Stamp

Palette Knife

Nuvo Expanding Mouse – Warm Linen Simon Says Stamp Sunken Treasure Sequins

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

Ranger Distress watercolor card stock

Hero Arts – Mist 4-1/4 x 11, score and fold at 5-1/2 – card base

4 x 5-1/4 - card front

 $3-1/2 \times 5$ – die cut eucalyptus leaves (2 sets)

2 x 4-1/2 – die cut eucalyptus leaves (1 set)

³/₄ x 2 – sentiment

DIRECTIONS:

White cardstock

Neenah Desert Storm

1. Protect your work surface with a craft sheet. Lay the 4 x 5-1/4 card front down and secure the stencil over it with Pixie Spray



- TIP PIXIE SPRAY, is a removable adhesive spray that will hold a stencil in place for you while you apply mouse etc.
- 2. Remove the stencil and set the piece aside to dry. Wash the stencil immediately to remove any product before it dries.
- 3. Die cut the leaves. Sponge the brown ones slightly at the base of each leaf.
- 4. Use the watercolors to color the other set of leaves and let them dry.
- 5. Stamp the sentiment in brown ink onto the small scrap of white cardstock.
- 6. Once the mouse is dry, use foam tape to attach it to the card front.
- 7. Use small pieces of foam tape to attach the brown leaves and then the water colored leaves.
- 8. Mix a small amount of Winsor & Newton Gouache with water and use a paint brush to splatter the card front.
- 9. Add a few of the copper sequins from the Sunken Treasure Sequins with the Tombow Multipurpose glue.
- 10. Make a double bow with the copper thread and attach it to the leaves with the Tombow Multi-purpose
- 11. Clean the stamp with the shammy


