

Spellbinders Small Die of the Month – November – Frankie goes to the North Pole

Technique: Die Cutting

Level: Beginner/Intermediate



TIME: around 30 – 45 minutes

Spellbinders Small Die of the Month Kit – November
Sentiment – Spellbinders Christmas Mix & Match Sentiments
Tool-n-one
FSJ White Glue
Paper Cutter
Bone Folder
White Paint, water, paint brush and a splatter box

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

FSJ White

8 x 9 – score at 4 – Slimline card base

3-3/4 x 3 – first mountain

3-3/4 x 5 – second mountain

Hero Arts Paradise

3-3/4 x 8-3/4 – card front

Scraps and pieces of light and dark green, red, black, gold, silver Iridized glimmer paper and brown.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Die cut all the pieces and use white glue to put them together. In the video I give you some tips for the trees and for inlaying the tiny pieces quickly and easily.
2. Mix the white paint with some water and use the brush to splatter across the top of the blue card front and set aside to dry.



3. Die cut the top of the two mountains with the Essentials Oval Dies
4. Use a tape runner to attach them to the blue card front and trim from the back if necessary, before mounting to the card base.
5. Die cut the sentiment and attach it to the bottom of the card.
6. Use the white glue to attach the trees and then small pieces of foam tape to attach the North Pole Sign and the snowman.
7. Die cut the snowball die twice with the glitter paper and use them to decorate the two trees, 3 on each.
