 $5-1/2 \times 8-1/2$ score and fold at 4-1/2 - card base.

4-1/4 x 5-1/2 – Die cut with rectangle and emboss

4 x 5-1/4 - cut sentiment circle

4-1/4 x 5-1/2 Stamp, color and cut out gnomes. 1 x 5-1/2 – background & die cut poinsettias (3)

4-1/2 x 5-1/2 – due cut greener




DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Place the card front inside the Plaid Company embossing folder and run it through the die cutting
- 2. Place the brown rectangle inside the Tiny Dot embossing folder and run it through the die cutting machine.
- 3. Use the Misti to stamp the gnomes on the quarter sheet of card stock.
- 4. Color with Copic markers and cut out.
- 5. Use the red ink to stamp the sentiments on the circle and on a scrap of white card, stamp the heart and cut out.
- 6. Die cut three poinsettias from the center of the strip of red before you attach it to the back of the brown rectangle.
- 7. Add adhesive to the center of the front of the red strip and attach it to the back of the brown rectangle.
- 8. Then attach both pieces to the center of the embossed card base.
- 9. Attach the white circle with foam squares.
- 10. Due cut the branches and holly from the green cardstock.
- 11. Use the Bearly White Glue to attach the greenery and then the poinsettias.
- 12. Attach the art with a foam square.
- 13. Add a small gem to the center of each poinsettia.
- 14. Clean the stamps with a shammy.
