Technique: Dye cutting/Embossing Level: Beginner/Intermediate

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

Hammermill #100 White

Gina K Lagoon Spellbinders Lilac Blossom Silver Glimmer Paper $4-1/4 \times 11$ – score and fold at 5-1/2 – card base.

4-1/4 x 5-1/2 - card front.

4-1/4 x 5-1/2 – die cut sentiments 3 times

4 x 4 – Die cut deer


1/8 x 4-1/4 – trim along bottom front of card

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Secure the card front to a protected work surface and using the Slim Line Double Tree Line Stencil and blending brushes, add the stack of trees for the background.
- 2. Use the blending brushes without reinking to add a bit of color to the sky
- 3. Mix some white paint and use the paint brush to splatter the card front.
- 4. Set the card front aside to dry.
- 5. Die cut the sentiment 3 times and the two large deer once each.
- 6. Use the Misti to stamp and white heat emboss the second sentiment onto one of the die cut sentiments.
- 7. Use the Bearly Art Glue to stack the sentiments.
- 8. Use the Tape runner to attach the card front to the card base.
- 9. Use the Bearly Art Glue to attach the deer to the card front
- 10. And use the Bearly Art Glue to attach the thin strip of silver glimmer paper to the bottom of the card front.
- 11. Again, use the Bearly Art Glue to attach the sentiment to the card
- 12. Use the embellishment wand to add the small holograph stars all over the card front
- 13. Clean the stamp with the stamp scrubber
