Spellbinders Penguins and Baubles

Technique: Stenciling/Die Cutting

Level: Beginner/Intermediate



TIME: about 20 minutes

STAMPS: None

INKS:

Simon Says Stamp: Seafoam and Surf Ink Altenew – Gold Pigment Ink.

ACCESSORIES:

Platinum 6 Die Cutting Machine Festive Friends, small die of the Month, Oct/24 Festive Lights Glimmer Hot foil Club, Oct/24 -sided tape Foam squares Paper Trimmer Gold Smooth Disc Sequins

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

White Cardstock (Hammermill)

Waterfall

4-1/4 x 11, score and fold at 5-1/2 – card base Scraps for die-cutting Penguin 4 x 5-1/4" – card front 1-1/2" x 4" glimmer sentiment

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Start with a piece of Waterfall cardstock 4" x 5-1/4" and stencil the Baubles from the Stencil of the Month Club. Ink in Seafoam ink, and then highlight the left side in Surf Ink for a darker shadow. Then, use Gold Pigment Ink for the hangers.
- 2. Next, attach to a top folding A2 sized white card base, $4-1/4" \times 11"$, score and fold at 5-1/2".



- 3. Then, using Polished Brass Glimmer Hot Foil, and the Festive Lights Glimmer Hot Foil Oct. kit, foil the sentiment and cut out with the coordinating dies.
- 4. Finally, die cut the little penguin from the Small Die of the Month Kit Festive Friends, and then embellish with Gold Smooth Disc sequins.
