Spellbinders Plaid and Penguin Card

Technique: BetterPress plaid Level: Beginner/Intermediate



BetterPress Plates – Design a Plaid Ruler Foam squares Black Copic Pen #52-sided tapePaper Trimmer

TIME: about 15 minutes

STAMPS:

Spellbinders – Holiday Besties

INKS:

Spellbinders BetterPress Ink: teal Topaz, Laurel Intense Black Ink – to stamp penguin Copic Markers:

Gray: N7, N8 Pink, RV11

Teal: BG11, BG13 Orange: YG03, YG17 Brown: E21, #23

ACCESSORIES:

Platinum 6 Die Cutting Machine BetterPress System Fluted Classic Circles

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

White Cardstock (Hammermill)

4-1/4 x 11, score and fold at 5-1/2 – card base 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" – card front 3 x 3" – die cut circle 2 x 2 – stamp, color and cut penguin

DIRECTIONS:

1. Start by using the Design a Plaid BetterPress of the Month and the Teal Topaz and Laurel BetterPress Ink pads to create the background. Print on a 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" piece of Hammermill white cardstock. This works up very quickly, as you turn the paper to make the plaid, instead of



- moving the plates, really cuts down the inking time. Once done, add some black lines with a ruler and Copic black pen.
- 2. Next, attach to a top folding A2 Sized white card base $4-1/4 \times 11$, score and fold at 5-1/2".
- 3. Then, cut out a white circle with the Fluted Classic Circles and attach to the center of the card.
- 4. Finally, stamp, color and cut out the adorable little penguin and the sentiment from the Holiday Besties Clear Stamp and Die set.
