

Spellbinders Plaid and Penguin Card

Technique: BetterPress plaid

Level: Beginner/Intermediate



TIME: about 15 minutes

STAMPS:

Spellbinders – Holiday Besties

INKS:

Spellbinders BetterPress Ink:
teal Topaz, Laurel

Intense Black Ink – to stamp
penguin

Copic Markers:

Gray: N7, N8

Pink, RV11

Teal: BG11, BG13

Orange: YG03, YG17

Brown: E21, #23

ACCESSORIES:

Platinum 6 Die Cutting Machine

BetterPress System

Fluted Classic Circles

BetterPress Plates – Design a Plaid

Ruler

Foam squares

- Black Copic Pen #5

2-sided tape

Paper Trimmer

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

White Cardstock (Hammermill)

4-1/4 x 11, score and fold at 5-1/2 – card base

4-1/4" x 5-1/2" – card front

3 x 3" – die cut circle

2 x 2 – stamp, color and cut penguin

DIRECTIONS:

1. Start by using the Design a Plaid BetterPress of the Month and the Teal Topaz and Laurel BetterPress Ink pads to create the background. Print on a 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" piece of Hammermill white cardstock. This works up very quickly, as you turn the paper to make the plaid, instead of



moving the plates, really cuts down the inking time. Once done, add some black lines with a ruler and Copic black pen.

2. Next, attach to a top folding A2 Sized white card base 4-1/4 x 11, score and fold at 5-1/2".
3. Then, cut out a white circle with the Fluted Classic Circles and attach to the center of the card.
4. Finally, stamp, color and cut out the adorable little penguin and the sentiment from the Holiday Besties Clear Stamp and Die set.
